Nomination & Selection Criteria

The Hall of Fame committee will select Rutgers University graduates who have distinguished themselves by contributions they have made to the community, to the University or in their fields of endeavor; by the leadership they have exhibited; and by the general benefits to the larger society resulting from their efforts. Selection will be based largely on accomplishments made since completing an undergraduate degree (from any college or university) The following are examples of categories:

- Arts, Entertainment & Literature
- Athletics
- Business & Entrepreneurship
- Community Service
- Education
- Government
- Journalism & Media
- Science, Technology & Medicine
- Other

Service to the University can include, but is not limited to:

- Support of Rutgers University students and student organizations
- Support of RAAA or other University Alumni Associations
- Participation in University and alumni boards or committees

Community Service can include, but is not limited to:

- Leadership and mentorship of future leaders
- Membership or support of civic, charitable or religious organizations
- Other community related volunteer or financial support

Career Achievement in the field can include, but is not limited to:

- Successful entrepreneurial ventures
- Professional highlights, honors and awards
- Publications

Rules for selection

- Nominee must have graduated from Rutgers University as of December of this year
- Nominee can have any degree from any school or college within Rutgers University
- Nominee cannot have been inducted into the Rutgers University Distinguished Hall of Alumni
- A complete nomination must be submitted or the nomination will be disqualified. A complete nomination includes:
 - Nominee name, college and class year
 - Nominee contact information
 - Detailed list of accomplishments
 - Optional supporting documentation: press releases, articles, resume/CV, publications and support letters

Upon selection, nominees must be able to attend the award dinner tentatively set for early October or the first available runners up will receive the award (unless awarded posthumously). However, under extenuating circumstances, as determined by the committee, an award may be given in absentia. Any nominations that did not receive awards will be held for consideration for the following year or may be submitted for consideration in the Rutgers University's Distinguished Hall of Alumni. If a selected nominee declines the award (except under circumstances approved by the selection committee), they will be disqualified from future consideration.

Honorary Lifetime Membership

RAAA may also choose to select a person who may or may not be a Rutgers graduate who has shown outstanding dedication in supporting and advancing the causes of the students and/or alumni.
